Materials & Designs

Granite - for everlasting memorials

Granite is the hardest material we offer and is extremely durable. It is available in a range of colours. Polishing granite brings out the true natural beauty of this material. A range of finishes can be seen throughout this brochure including polished, honed and rustic effects. Ornamentation is achieved by carving, etching or sandblasting.

Italian White Marble - the traditional memorial material

Sourced from Italy. Marble was once a very popular material and is known for its ease of carving. The appearance of this material has been synonymous with the splendour of memorial carvings for centuries. Ideally, marble should not be used near trees or in damp areas due to its porous nature which can cause it to attract mould or algae.

Stone

Materials such as nabresina, Portland stone and sandstone (see pages 34-35) are mainly used in churchyards where their neutral tones are widely accepted.


The Memorial

Looking through this brochure you will find a large choice of memorials in various styles and colours. Granite memorials can be chosen in any colour (see pages 34-35) and many elements are interchangeable so you can create the design that best suits your requirements.

The Inscription

Once you have selected the memorial the next step is to choose the wording for the inscription. A selection of popular inscriptions and verses are shown below but a more comprehensive list is available on request. You also have the freedom to compose a message that expresses your own sentiments. Be sure to discuss the inscription with relatives and close friends, and feel free to contact us if you require any guidance. Once you have decided on the inscription we will send you a proof layout. You can then make any changes if needed before our masons begin their work.

Fixing Methods


